He is board certified in Internal Medicine (1975), Cardiology (1979) and Interventional Cardiology (1999). He has served as Director of the Cardiac Catheterization Laboratory, Director of Cardiology and Program Director of Interventional Cardiology at the University of Texas Medical Branch in Galveston, Texas.
